Dear Parents and Carers,

We are making changes across the Trust regarding the children attending school this term so that **all children will have the opportunity to come into school at some point before the summer rather than a complete 6 months away from school**. Ideally, we would have accommodated all of our pupils currently attending too but it is not possible with the space and staff available here to do this and maintain the safety for our pupils and continue to follow government guidance. The pre-school will remain open until Friday July 17th.

Until Friday 3rd July, we shall operate as we currently are with pre-school, Reception, Year 1, Key Workers & Vulnerable and Year 6 eligible to attend. The last two weeks of term will be structured as below. **Please drop off all of your siblings at the allocated time of your youngest sibling.**

Children attending school will have the option of a reduced menu from our school caterers or to bring in a packed lunch.

We recognise that sending your child in or not is a difficult decision for some families to make, as it is not possible for an education setting to remove all risk of transmission. We shall, however, continue with our current rigorous procedures within the school regarding handwashing, respiratory hygiene, frequent cleaning, ventilation and staggered toilet breaks/meal times/arrivals/departures etc.

The school buses are already full with key worker children currently attending so you would need to arrange your own transport. The bus companies can only operate with a very limited number of passengers.

Teachers will continue to provide home learning for all pupils until the end of term. Year 6 will have a Leaver's Picnic on Friday July 3rd (or earlier in that week if forecast is rain). More details will follow for families of Year 6 children.

The term will end for all children on Friday July 17th.
