



PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING 2016-17 HARBERTONFORD

Purpose of Funding

The government continues to provide PE and Sports Premium Grant for improving physical education and sport in primary schools for 2016-2017. The funding is allocated directly to primary schools and schools can choose how they use funding for example to:

- hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers during PE lessons
- support and involve the least active children by running after-school sports clubs e.g. Change4Life clubs
- provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers
- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation in the School Games
- run sports activities with other schools
