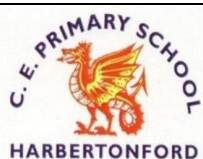


Pupil Premium Data 2015-2016



Overview for Harbertonford CE Primary School

After careful consideration of evidence and or own school priorities, during 2015/2016 we spent the money on:

- Continued provision for vulnerable children to have access to "Thrive Support Sessions."
- Continued provision for some children to have additional 1:1, small group teaching sessions to support learning in English and Maths.
- Continued provision for some children to have additional 1:1 precision teaching and phonics support
- Training for staff working with pupils who need specialist teaching/support.
- Milk is provided for all children
- Continued to provide additional enrichment opportunities including school trips, forest school, additional sporting opportunities and school visitors.

Outcomes to date – Progress of Pupil Premium Pupils 2015/2016

Reading: 47% at ARE, 7% above ARE, 47% below ARE

Writing: 40% at ARE, 0% above ARE, 60 % below ARE

Maths: 33% at ARE, 7% above ARE, 60% below ARE

Planned Spending and Actions for 2016/2017

- Continued provision for vulnerable children to have access to "Thrive Support Sessions."
- Develop extra curricula opportunities, targeting the needs of pupil premium children
- Provide regular forest school enrichment
- Source further resources to support pupils in closing the gaps
- Increase support for children who are working below age related expectations, particularly for precision teaching and phonics support
- TA training for behaviour support
- Ensure milk continues to be available for all
